

Taylorsville High School Women's Soccer Team Expectations 2021

Practice:

Practices are Monday through Friday any day we don't have games, they go from 3:00pm to 5:00pm, and are considered mandatory. If a player decides to not come to practice for any reason their playing time for the next game will be substantially decreased. We have to practice as a whole team to get better and if someone isn't coming for any reason, they aren't helping the team as a whole improve. All girls need to be at the field by 2:45pm to get things set up and ready for practice to start. If any girl is late to practice, they will be required to run extra laps or go home for the day. No cell phones are allowed out at practices and will not be tolerated unless something urgent comes up. Also, no gear will be taken off until everything is put away and the team has cheered out, which is excusing everyone for the day.

Games:

Games are Tuesdays and Thursdays for the rest of the season. Again, cell phones will not be allowed out at games unless something urgent comes up. Because we are a small team this year, every girl is required to be dressed and warmed up for varsity and keep their gear on throughout the JV game. Everyone will be required to play in both games, unless they get injured which will be assessed by George and McCall and our Taylorsville trainer or the away team's trainer. All gear is required to stay on throughout both games until everything has been put away or gathered to get back on the bus and the team has cheered out.

Home Games: the girls will be required to be out by 2:20pm at the latest to get the field set up for the game and ensure everything is ready for the visiting team as they arrive. If something comes up and a girl has to leave a home game early, a parent must come and check them out by George or McCall.

Away Games: the girls will be excused from class early for the bus to leave right at 2:00pm. Girls need to quickly change and get their things to help load up the bus to leave on time. Every girl **MUST** ride the bus to and from all away games. If something is urgent and a girl has to leave, a parent must come over to check them out by George or McCall.

Team:

As of July 28, 2021, every girl committed to be on the Taylorsville High School women's soccer team. This means we work as a team, practice as a team, grow as a team, and win or lose as a team. No one girl is better than anyone else and needs to be positively cheering on, encouraging, and supporting their teammates. If we hear of negative talk going on it will immediately be stopped and addressed with the girls involved. If it continues, we will get parents and administration involved. Soccer is a team sport and requires everyone to be working cohesively together.

Parents:

Parents, please ensure you're coming to the game to cheer on your daughter and her teammates. Please do not coach on the sidelines or talk down to any of the girls on our team or the team we are playing. We are growing, learning, and developing together and need your positive reinforcements to help us cheer on the team. We are hoping you can help us set a good example of

being supportive and positive through the games, like we are asking the girls to do. If you have concerns or questions, please feel free to come address them at the end of any practice with George and McCall.

Consequences:

Consequences are the result of any action, whether positive or negative. We will address all situations individually and establish the appropriate consequence for each player.
